
DIAGRAM ILLUSTRATES THE BREAKDOWN OF FUNCTIONAL RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN ALL NOTED ZONES OF THE PROGRAM.

EACH CURRICULUM AREA IS ITEMIZED RELATIVE TO STUDENT ZONES, TEACHING ZONES AND STORAGE ZONES. BULK AREAS SUCH AS RESOURCE CENTRE AND ADMINISTRATION ARE ITEMIZED RELATIVE TO THE INDIVIDUAL ROOMS.

ALL ITEMS ARE REFERENCED AS PER THEIR CATEGORY NUMBER OF THE CURRICULUM PROGRAM AND THE AREA SPREADSHEET SUMMARY AND BREAKDOWNS.

FUNCTIONAL LINKS ARE ILLUSTRATED BY THE VARIOUS LINES BETWEEN EACH ZONE. THE PRIORITY OF THE RELATIONSHIP IS INDICATED BY THE LINE COLOUR AND TYPE.

DIAGRAM IS USED TO ESTABLISH THE FUNCTIONAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY AREAS OF THE FACILITY.
